



# District-reported 2003 results

### Teacher pay

 The teacher and instructional aide earned between \$4,087 and \$5,865 in additional salary.

## Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school performance.
- Curriculum was aligned to state standards and the teacher and aide began developing AIMS intervention tutoring materials to help improve student achievement.
- The student absenteeism rate was 8 percent or less.
- Other goals were linked to the teacher and aide receiving acceptable performance evaluations and completing professional development courses.

### Menu

 Monies were used to compensate the teacher and aide for efforts to align curriculum with state standards, and for completing 68 hours of professional development activities relating to special education, student evaluation, and behavior management.
