Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

The Annual Expenditure Limitation Report (AELR) is presented as prescribed by the Uniform Expenditure Reporting System (UERS), as required by Arizona Revised Statutes §41-1279.07. The AELR excludes expenditures or deductions of certain revenues specified in the Arizona Constitution, Article IX, §20, from the total expenditures or deductions reported in the fund financial statements.

In accordance with the UERS, a note to the AELR is presented below for any exclusion claimed on Part II and each subtraction in the Reconciliation that cannot be traced directly to an amount reported in the fund financial statements. All references to financial statement amounts in the following notes refer to the Statement of Revenues, Expenditures, and Changes in Fund Balances for the Governmental Funds and the Statement of Changes in Fiduciary Net Position for the Fiduciary Funds.

- Note 2 The exclusion claimed for debt service requirements on bonded indebtedness in the Governmental Funds consists of principal and interest expenditures.
- Note 3 The exclusion claimed for dividends, interest, and gains on the sale or redemption of investment securities of \$2,207,910 in the Governmental Funds includes investment earnings expended of \$186,503 and interest on delinquent taxes expended of \$2,021,407, which was recorded as tax revenue. The exclusion claimed for dividends, interest, and gains on the sale or redemption of investment securities of \$452,573 in the Fiduciary Funds consists of interest on investments that was reported as investment income.
- Note 4 The exclusion claimed for trustee or custodian of \$3,514,719 in the Governmental Funds consists of \$1,885,053 in contributions by the County to the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS) for acute care, uncompensated care, and administrative costs; anti-racketeering costs of \$889,649; inmate health services costs of \$13,706; jail commissary costs of \$594,943; and inmate food costs of \$131,368. In the Fiduciary Fund, the exclusion consists of \$359,524,426 in distributions to investment pool participants.
- Note 5 The following schedule presents revenues from which exclusions have been claimed for federal grants and aid, amounts received from the State of Arizona, and highway user revenues in the Governmental Funds:

- Note 6 The exclusion claimed for contracts with other political subdivisions of \$807,068 includes \$30,515 of charges for services expended and \$776,553 of miscellaneous revenues expended.
- Note 7 The subtraction of \$18,830,573 for separate legal entities established under Arizona Revised Statutes consists of expenditures of special assessment districts included within the County's reporting entity, but not included in the Economic Estimates Commission base limit calculations, and are reported in the Governmental Funds category in the fund financial statements:

- Note 8 The subtraction for long-term care contributions withheld by the State Treasurer consists of transaction privilege taxes the State Treasurer withheld to meet the County's share of long-term care costs that was reported as revenue and an offsetting expenditure in the County's Governmental Funds. Consequently, this expenditure has been subtracted on the Reconciliation.
- Note 9 The subtraction of \$452,531 for payments made to reimburse the Arizona Department of Health Services consists of county payments to reimburse the State for part of the costs of commitment of an individual the court determined to be sexually violent, as required by Laws 2012, Chapter 299, Sections 10 and 11, which were recorded as general government expenditures.
