### Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

The Annual Budgeted Expenditure Limitation Report (ABELR) is presented as prescribed by the Uniform Expenditure Reporting System (UERS), as required by Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) §41-1279.07. The ABELR excludes expenditures of certain revenues specified in the Arizona Constitution, Article IX, §21, from the total budgeted expenditures.

The information reported in both the ABELR and the financial statements is derived from the same underlying accounting data. However, the formats of the ABELR and the financial statements differ. The ABELR presents budgeted expenditures, exclusions, and amounts subject to the limitation by fund type as required by A.R.S. §41-1279.07. The financial statements present the net position, changes in net position, and cash flows in accordance with U.S. generally accepted accounting principles.

In accordance with the UERS requirements, a note to the ABELR is presented below for any exclusion reported in the Total column on Part II that cannot be traced directly to an amount reported in the annual financial statements.

- Note 2 Of the \$149,197 in investment earnings reported on the Statement of Revenues, Expenses and Changes in Net Position—Primary Government, only \$128,933 was expended and claimed as an exclusion. The remaining \$20,264 consists of \$1,062 of interest income in the Loan Fund, which was not excludable, and \$19,202 of investment earnings in the Retirement of Indebtedness Fund, which has been carried forward to future years.
- Note 3 Of the \$24,940,079 reported as government grants on the Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Net Position—Primary Government, only \$24,061,268 was expended and claimed as an exclusion. The remaining \$878,811 was not excludable revenue.
- Note 4 The \$259,522 exclusion claimed for interfund transactions in the General Fund consists of amounts expended from indirect cost recoveries that were budgeted as General Fund revenue and Restricted Fund and Auxiliary Fund expenses. These indirect cost recoveries were eliminated from the financial statements for financial reporting purposes because they do not represent transactions to external parties.
- Note 5 The \$514,285 excluded for amounts accumulated for the purchase of land and the purchase or construction of buildings or improvements consists of monies accumulated in the Unexpended Plant Fund, with the District Governing Board's approval. These funds were used for building improvements and are included in the amount reported as purchases of capital assets on the Statement of Cash Flows—Primary Government.

Note 6 - The District does not budget tuition and fees revenue net of scholarship allowances. Of the gross tuition and fees of \$13,815,772 reported on the Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Net Position—Primary Government, only \$10,361,829 was expended and claimed as an exclusion. The remaining \$3,453,943 has been carried forward to future years.
