**Subject: Valley Union High School District—No longer in Noncompliance with Audit Reporting Requirements**

Dear Members of the State Board:

In our July 23, 2024, letter to you, we requested that the Arizona State Board of Education (State Board) take action on Valley Union High School District because the District had not submitted its audit reports and the *Uniform System of Financial Records Compliance Questionnaire* (Questionnaire) for the year ended June 30, 2023. Although late, we have now received the District's fiscal year (FY) 2023 reports and Questionnaire. Therefore, the District has met the report submission requirements for that year.

Now that we have received the District's required reports and Questionnaire, we will begin our review of the FY 2023 reports to assess whether the District has complied with the USFR and we will notify the District and the State Board if it has not complied.
