




### Classroom Dollars

### District-reported 2003 results

#### Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$1,373 in salary, each instructional aide earned an additional \$410, and each counselor earned an additional \$234.

#### Performance

- The District did not accomplish its goal, which required at least 1 year's academic progress in grades 2 through 9 as measured by standardized tests.

#### Menu

- Teachers were compensated for participating in professional development activities.
