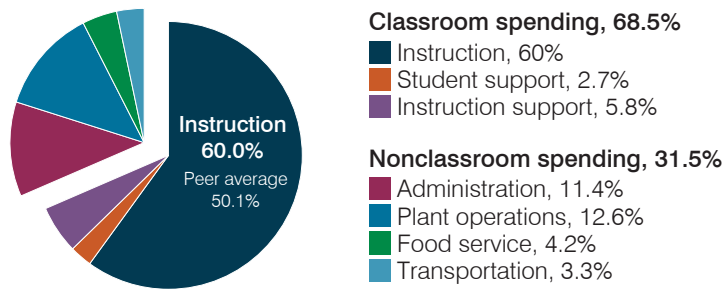

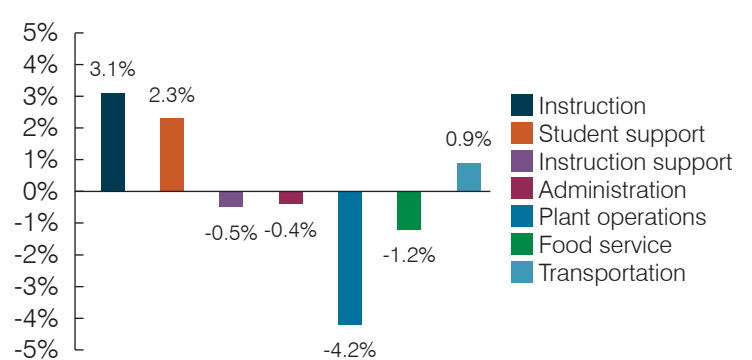
Spending by operational area



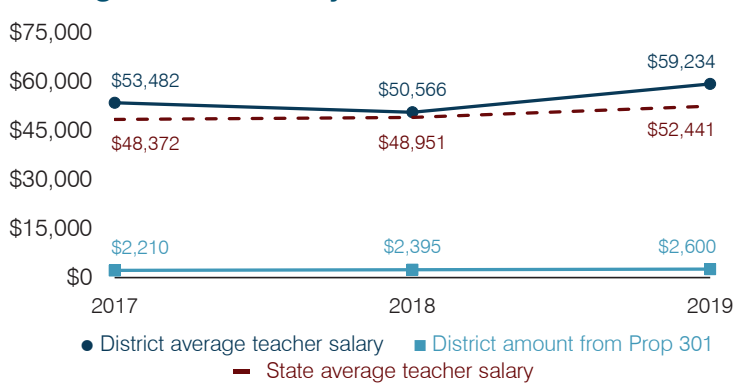

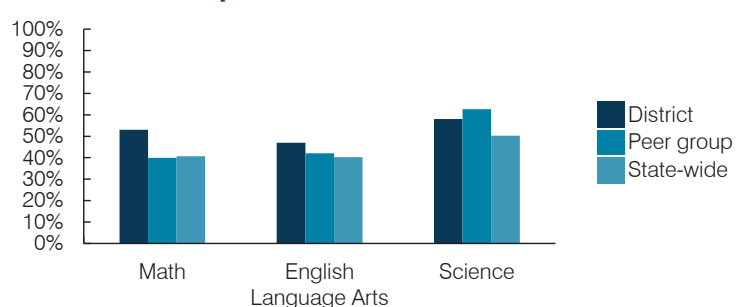
