



District-reported 2008 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$4,974 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished most of its goals, which were the same as the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on district performance.
- The goal not met required at least 80 percent of students in attendance since the beginning of the school year to meet or exceed state standards on standardized tests.
- Teachers completed 20 hours of professional development activities.
- At least 75 percent of families attended school open houses and family night activities.
- At least 75 percent of the parents and students randomly surveyed rated the school's overall performance as "good" or "excellent."

Menu

- Monies were used primarily to increase teacher compensation.
- One teacher earned an additional \$300 for obtaining an Early Childhood endorsement.
