



### Proposition 301

#### District-reported 2008 results

##### Teacher pay

- The teacher earned an additional \$8,926 in salary.

##### Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on individual performance.
- The student attendance goal was achieved.
- 90 percent of students indicated satisfaction with the school.
- Tutoring was available daily and once a week at night.

##### Menu

- The teacher was compensated for participating in a summer dropout prevention program, which the District reports helped 9 at-risk students earn credits toward graduation.
