During the webinar, a participant asked where they could find information on the CIP codes included in the Chart of Accounts along with the new JTED program codes in the 300-399 range, to read more about the related CTE programs. We also had a question during the webinar on the use of JTED monies to support CTE courses for 9th grade students even though those students do not generate JTED funding. A.R.S. §15-393, paragraph D.4.b states that, "a student in a kindergarten program or in grades one through nine who is enrolled in career and technical education courses shall not be funded in whole or in part with monies provided by a joint technical education district, except that a pupil in grade eight or nine may be funded with monies generated by the five cent qualifying tax rate..."

Therefore, if a JTED passes through monies to a member district from its qualifying tax levy, rather than from state equalization assistance, the agreement between the JTED and the member district could allow for those monies to be used to support CTE courses for students in 8th or 9th grade.
