



District-reported 2008 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher and counselor earned an additional \$6,249 in salary, which includes performance pay for fiscal year 2007 performance.

Performance

- The District accomplished most of its goals, which were the same as the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on district performance.
- The District met 4 of its 5 goals requiring the percentage of students meeting or exceeding reading, math, and writing standards on standardized tests to increase from the prior fiscal year.
- The goal not met required the District to decrease its dropout rate.

Menu

- 50 percent of monies were distributed to teachers who have received an evaluation with no areas needing improvement and/or rated as unsatisfactory.
- The remaining 50 percent of monies were distributed to teachers who completed 24 hours of extracurricular instruction or activities with students and/or parents.
