



District-reported 2008 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$6,423 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district performance.
- 65 percent of students scored 65 percent or better on district math assessments each quarter.
- Teachers developed and maintained curriculum maps and district assessments for reading and math.
- The District maintained an average daily attendance rate of at least 90 percent by the 100th day of school.
- Parents surveyed about teacher performance by the District indicated a 70 percent or higher satisfaction rate, and students indicated an 80 percent or higher satisfaction rate.

Menu

- The District continued to compensate teachers for participating in extra activities, such as overseeing student activities and tutoring.
- Some monies continued to be used to pay for benefits.
