


Fiscal year 2007 averages per pupil

District-reported 2007 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher and librarian earned between \$5,059 and \$6,610 in additional salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were similar to the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on school and individual performance.
- Student attendance exceeded 95 percent during state testing.
- Teachers received acceptable performance evaluations, participated in leadership activities, and completed instructional activities important to student achievement of academic standards.

Menu

- Monies were used primarily to increase eligible employee compensation.
- 130 students at risk for dropping out received counseling, 229 truancy letters were sent to parents, and 58 students were referred to school resource officers for truancy citations.
