


Classroom Dollars

District-reported 2003 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$3,672 in salary, and the librarian earned an additional \$4,491, which includes fiscal year 2002 performance pay distributed in fiscal year 2003.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school performance.
- Students' reading, math, and language arts scores increased, on average, on standardized tests.

Menu

- Monies were used primarily to increase eligible employee base pay.
- 27 teachers were also compensated for participating in professional development workshops.
