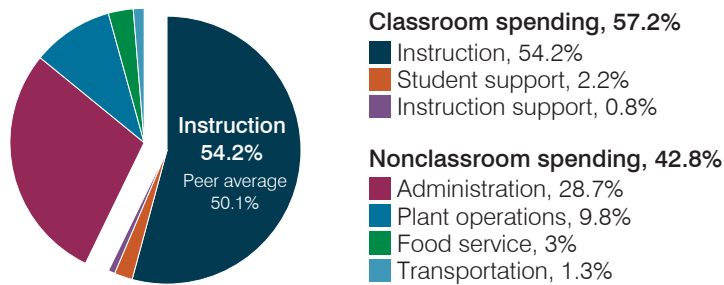

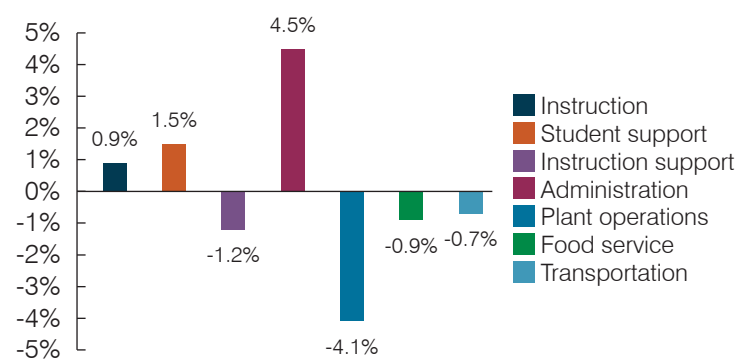
Spending by operational area



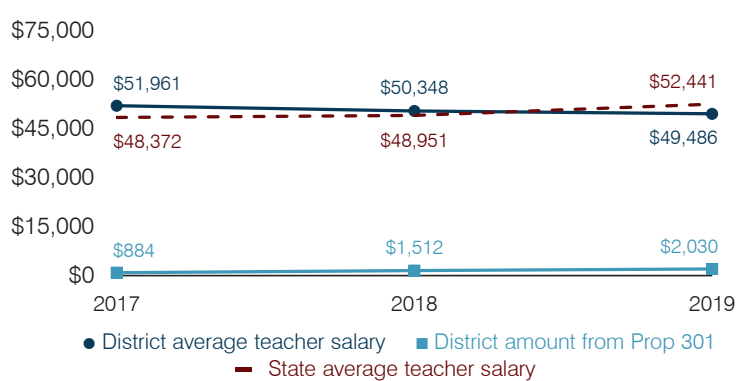
